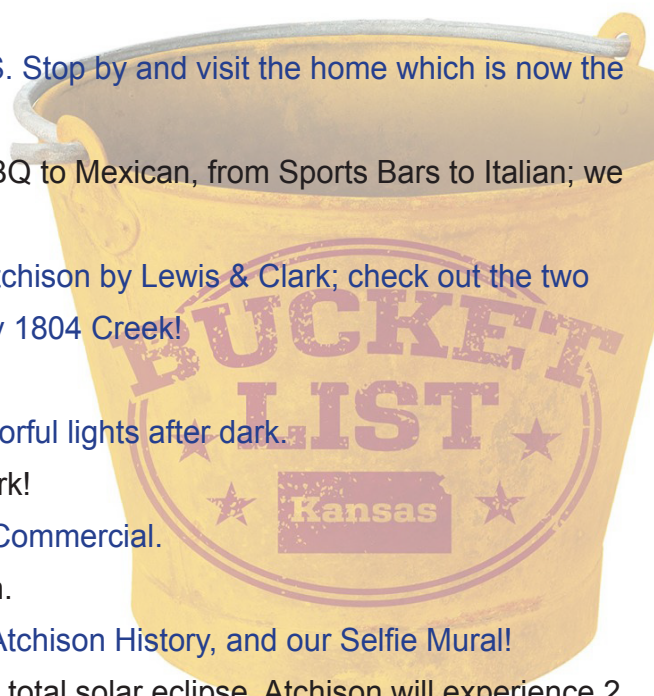


# Atchison

- Stop by the Visitor's Center and take a photo as Amelia Earhart!
- Explore 19th Century Atchison Architecture at the Muchnic Art Gallery now until July 30th.
- Celebrate the 21st Annual Amelia Earhart Festival July 14th-15th as we celebrate the 85th anniversary of Amelia's flight becoming the 1st woman to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean.
- Take a trip back to yesteryear at the 1882 Evah C. Cray Historical Home Museum, open daily during the summer.
- Take a 1-hour narrated tour to see the unique architecture and hear the legendary stories of Atchison's history offered Thursday's-Sunday's.
- Don't miss Big and Rich with Cam and Erik Dylan at the July 14th LakeFest Concert.
- Play a round of disc golf at Jackson Park.
- You won't want to miss the largest fireworks display in the Midwest, all orchestrated to music over the Missouri River on July 15th!
- Shop in our unique downtown stores and don't miss First Friday's on August 4th as well as Ladies Night Out on July 13th.
- Don't miss the Farmer's Market every Wednesday and Friday, and if you're in town August 12th don't miss the Tooty Fruity Pancake Festival.
- Head out to the International Forest of Friendship; a living, growing memorial to the world history of aviation and aerospace. With trees from all 50 states and over 32 countries, find and take a selfie with the tree from your home state or country.
- Amelia Earhart was born July 24th, 1897 right here in Atchison, KS. Stop by and visit the home which is now the Amelia Earhart Birthplace Museum.
- Take a dinner break at one of Atchison's many restaurants from BBQ to Mexican, from Sports Bars to Italian; we have something for everyone!
- The first Fourth of July west of the Mississippi was celebrated in Atchison by Lewis & Clark; check out the two local streams they named; Independence Creek and Fourth of July 1804 Creek!
- Enjoy a scenic summer drive along the Glacial Hills Scenic Byway.
- Watch the sunset over the Missouri River and stay and see the colorful lights after dark.
- Visit one of the 8 wonders of Kansas; The Amelia Earhart Earthwork!
- Let the kids cool off at the splash pad, located at the 400 block of Commercial.
- Take a special summer Haunted History Trolley Tour on August 5th.
- Visit one or all of our four building murals; Jesse Stone, Railroad, Atchison History, and our Selfie Mural!
- EXTRA EXTRA!! Atchison is the place to be on August 21st for the total solar eclipse. Atchison will experience 2 minutes and 19 seconds of totality during the first coast to coast eclipse since 1918!
