Also view Aerial Abstracts, an eighteen-piece collection of original paintings created by Amelia Rose Earhart to commemorate her world flight in 2014. Each canvas represents a leg of her long journey in a single-engine plane. This collection is on its way to Iceland by way of Atchison.


The 2019 Pioneering Achievement Award will jointly honor Grace McGuire, pilot, mechanic, and restorer of "Muriel," the last remaining Lockheed L-10E aircraft identical to the plane Amelia flew in her quest to circumnavigate the world; and Grace Muriel Earhart Morrissey, sister of Amelia Earhart, known affectionately as "Pidge." More than Amelia's

sister, Muriel was an educator, a civil activist, historian, an author and poet, a wife and mother.

In 1921 Amelia received her first flight instruction. The 23rd Annual Amelia Earhart Festival celebrates not only Earhart's storied flying career, but also the spirit of adventure she possessed and the determination that took her from Atchison to universal fame and admiration. She has become a role model for all children, many who desire to "do it because you want to do it." This year we celebrate the 90th Anniversaries of Amelia becoming the first woman to fly across the Atlantic as a passenger and to be the first woman to make a solo round trip flight across the United States.
